8:00 AM **Breakfast at the Hilton Garden Inn Kalamazoo Downtown** 303 N. Rose St.

Enjoy breakfast at the Hilton Garden Inn in downtown Kalamazoo, across the street from the Radisson. Opened in May of 2021, the Hilton Garden Inn is located in the historic Masonic Temple Building, also known as the Rose Street Market Building. Built by famed architectural firm Spier & Rohns, the structure was added to the U.S. National Register of Historic Places in 1980! Take a tour of this historic hotel which features 114 guest rooms and 2,112 square feet of meeting space in addition to a full-service restaurant, bar, indoor pool and fitness center.

10:00 AM **Air Zoo Aerospace & Science Museum** 6151 Portage Rd.

Take a self-guided tour of the Air Zoo. The Air Zoo is a world-class, Smithsonian-affiliated aerospace and science museum with over 100 air and space artifacts, inspiring interactive exhibits, full-motion flight simulators, indoor amusement park rides and hands-on, science-based camps and classes. Too overwhelmed to take a self-guided tour? Or maybe you want to learn more in-depth history on the planes themselves? Feel free to ask one of Air Zoo's many volunteer docents to take you around!
